Federal Active Transportation Funding Grants Open to Applicants

March 12, 2021 the Federal Government announced the creation of a new Active Transportation funding model pegged at \$400M over five years in support of the Federal Active Transportation Strategy.

As safe cycling advocates, Durham Region Cycling Coalition (DRCC) has been following this program closely and have provided communication updates via e-mail as details emerge to the Region of Durham and the eight lower tier Municipalities.

With the Federal Government announcing on January 27, 2022 that the Active Transportation Fund was now accepting applications, we have once again reached out to the Region of Durham and the eight lower tier Municipalities with this most recent update.
