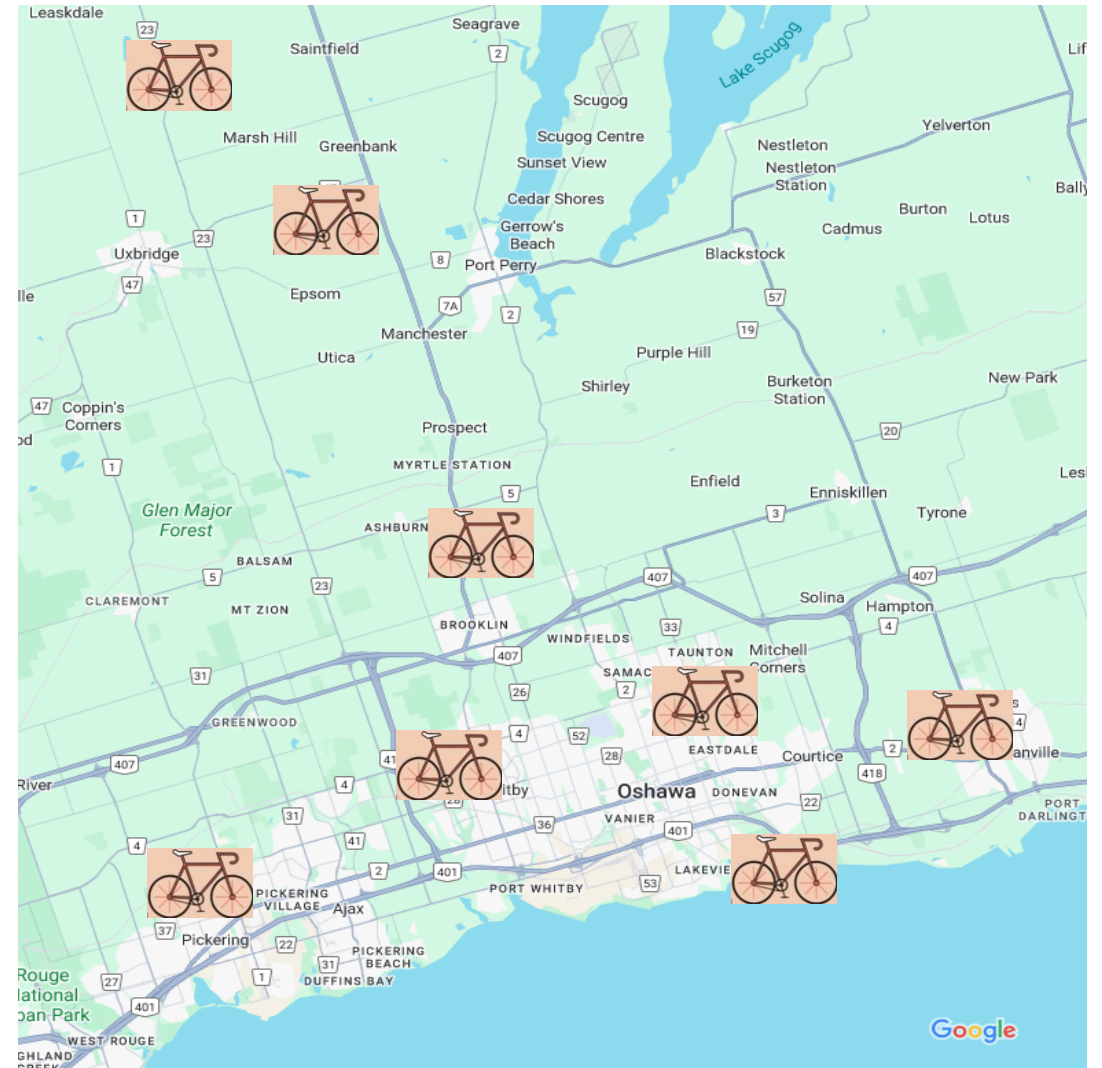

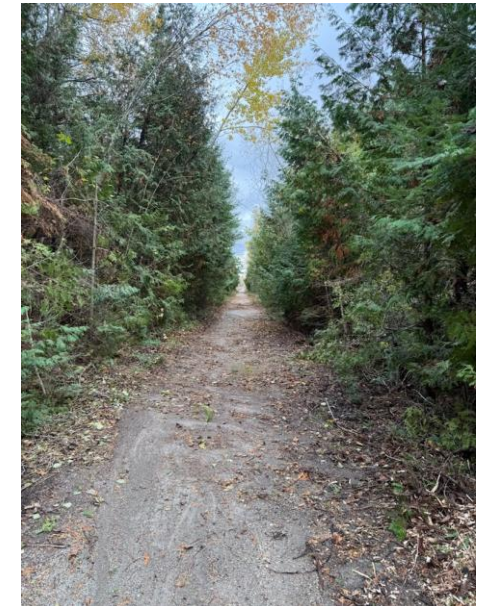
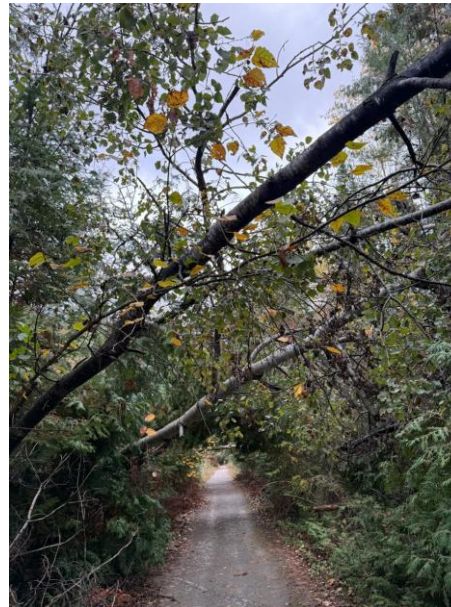

North Durham TransCanada Rail Trail.

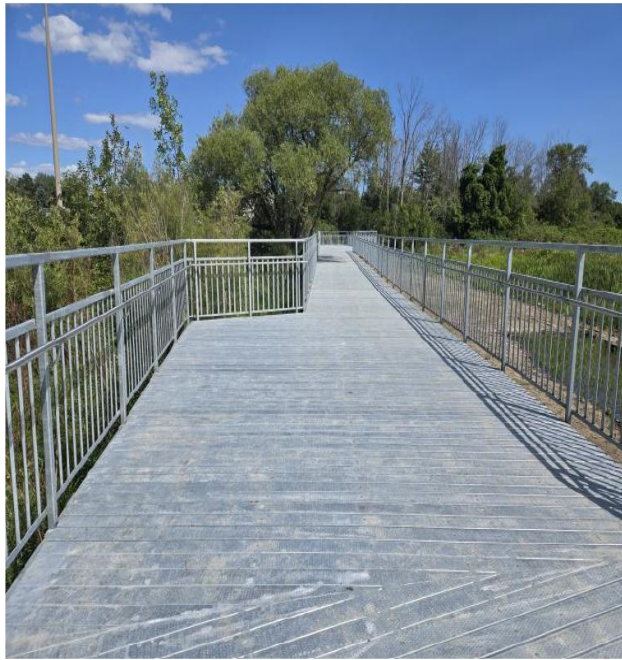
March 2025	Major Ice Storm damage.
April 2025	Clean up estimates coordinated and submitted - plus \$30K
April 2025	Lease holder – EOTA – lack of funds to support cleanup with 1/3rd available and 2/3rds unsupported.
June 2025	DRCC organized primary stakeholder meeting held.
July 2025	EOTA funding challenge continues, application submitted by EOTA to province, ice storm damage.
October 2025	Limited funding made available by EOTA and first stage contractor clean up completed.

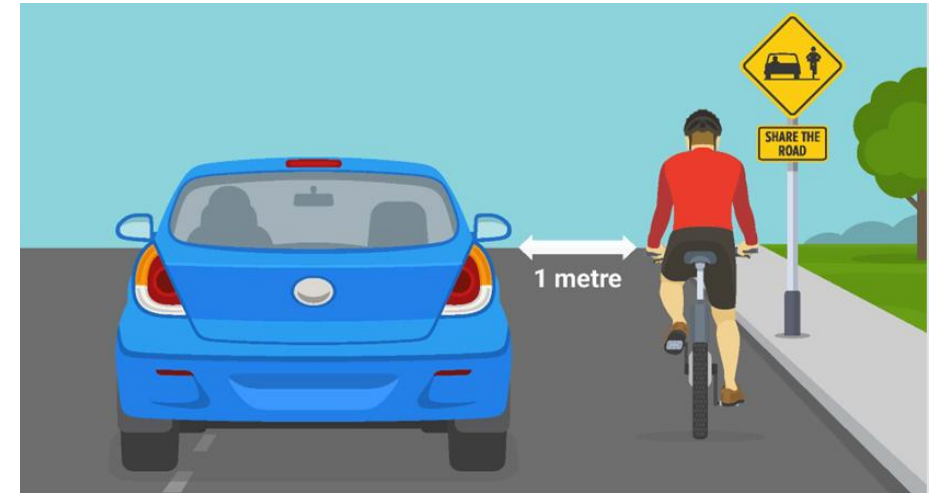

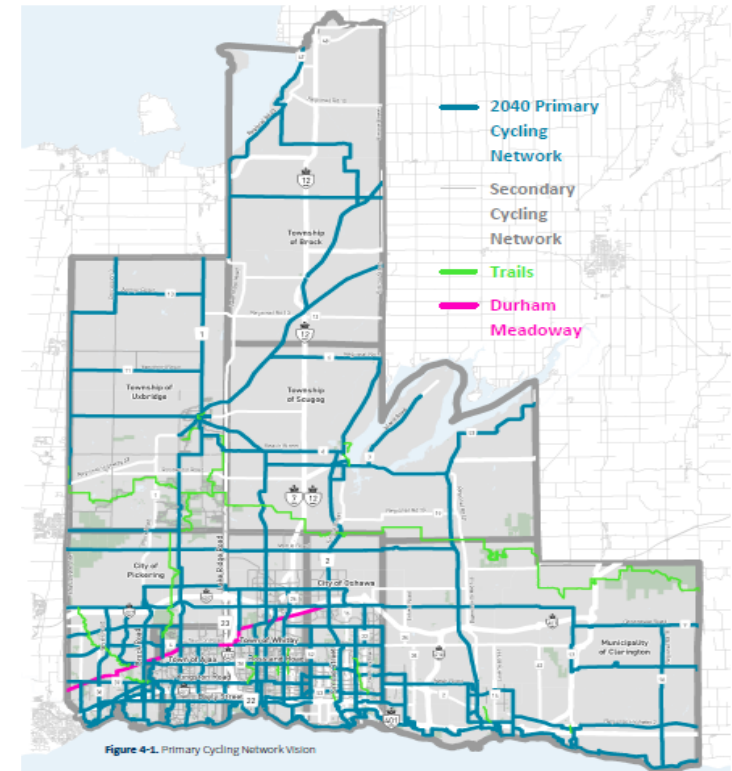
