Re: Algoma Intersection Highway, #2 and Regional Road 42 Signal Light Request

Good morning, Steve,

This intersection is heavily used by local cyclists and cycling clubs, as it provides an excellent stopping point at Algoma Orchards. Many riders use Regional Road 42 and Kurve Inn Road as a north—south connection from the Great Lakes Waterfront Trail to the Greenbelt Route, with Algoma Orchards serving as a bike-friendly rest stop.

We would like to request consideration for a traffic light at the intersection of Regional Road 42 and Highway 2. It is often very difficult for eastbound traffic to safely turn onto Highway 2. In addition, it would greatly improve safety for cyclists if the shoulder along this section of Highway 2 could be paved to a width of 1.5 metres on both sides.
