We have been actively involved with our municipality of Clarington, Durham Region and the Ministry of Transportation for Ontario (MTO) in these endeavors.

We have been advocating for these 3 issues for some time now and feel that any progress will show a willingness of DR to reach out and work with a valuable resource like Clarington's Bike Friendly advocacy group.

Our #1 item has been the connector link from Nash Rd via DR #57 to Longworth.

Our #2 item has been the safe connection from Baseline Rd via DR #34 (going under the 401) to the S. Service Rd.

Our #3 item has been getting "Bike Sharrows" painted on the road surface on DR #17 from Robert St to Toronto Rd, (this is on Mill St in Newcastle)
