## MEMORANDUM– Pickering Road Improvements

October 11, 2016

### Gravel Road Paving

1. Westney Rd: 7<sup>th</sup> Conc. to 8<sup>th</sup> Conc./to 9<sup>th</sup> Conc.
  - a. Provide paved shoulders/bike lane.
2. Sideline 14: Hwy 407 to 7<sup>th</sup> Conc.
  - a. Not a preferred cycling route. Just a link between Hwy 7 and 7<sup>th</sup> Conc.
  - b. MTO/ Hwy 407 did not pave the bridge approach shoulders. Will the City?
3. Would like to see the bike path paved under Hwy 407 on Paddock Rd which is a cycling route.
4. 7<sup>th</sup> Concession: Sideline 32 to Sideline 26/ Sideline 26 to Sideline 22/ Sideline 22 to Brock Rd.
  - a. 7<sup>th</sup> Conc. east of Brock Rd is a major E-W cycling route connecting to Columbus Rd at Lake Ridge Rd.
  - b. Extending the 7<sup>th</sup> Conc. west of Brock Rd. is an excellent addition to this key cycling route
  - c. Provide paved shoulders/bike lane.
5. Kingsale Rd: Hwy 407 to 7<sup>th</sup> Conc.
  - a. Should go from Hwy 7 to the 7<sup>th</sup> Conc. This would connect to Audley Rd. which in Ajax has dedicated bike lanes and a safe N-S cycling route.
  - b. MTO/ Hwy 407 did not pave the bridge approach shoulders. Will the City?
  - c. Provide paved shoulders/bike lane.
6. Sideline 24: hwy 407 to Whitevale Rd
  - a. Not a significant cycling route.
7. Other Considerations
  - a. Sideline 20: 7<sup>th</sup> Conc. to Scarborough/ Pickering Townline Rd.
    - i. Desperately needed N-S route avoiding Brock Rd.

### Road Reconstruction

1. Salem Rd: Hwy 7 to 5<sup>th</sup> Conc.
  - a. A good N-S cycling route from Ajax.
  - b. Provide paved shoulders/bike lane.
  - c. Salem Rd. north of Hwy 7 recently repaved but paved shoulders/bike lane omitted.
  - d. MTO/ Hwy 407 did not pave the bridge approach shoulders.
2. 6<sup>th</sup> Conc.: Westney Rd to Greenwood Rd.
  - a. A very welcome improvement.
  - b. Should include length from Greenwood Rd to Hwy 7 (260 m)
  - c. Mini roundabout could be improved to ensure traffic goes in correct direction.
3. Scarborough/ Pickering Townline Rd: Finch Ave to 3<sup>rd</sup> Conc.
  - a. Provide paved shoulders/bike lane.
4. 7<sup>th</sup> Conc Rd: York RR 30 to Sideline 32.
